In the identified area, the current year population is 49,403. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 43,892. The rate of change since 2010 was 1.91% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 55,444 representing a change of 2.33% annually from 2016 to 2021. Currently, the population is 50.7% male and 49.3% female.

## **Median Age**

The median age in this area is 57.3, compared to U.S. median age of 38.0.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 24.6% of the population in the identified area compared to 17.9% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 51.7 in the identified area, compared to 63.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 44.9% of the 36,722 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 16.3%, renter occupied; and 38.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 31,695 housing units in the area - 48.6% owner occupied, 14.5% renter occupied, and 36.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 6.76%. Median home value in the area is \$317,414, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.40% annually to \$340,202.
