In the identified area, the current year population is 180,973. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 157,482. The rate of change since 2010 was 1.94% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 201,912 representing a change of 2.21% annually from 2017 to 2022. Currently, the population is 48.9% male and 51.1% female.

## Median Age

The median age in this area is 45.4, compared to U.S. median age of 38.2.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 22.1% of the population in the identified area compared to 18.1% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 50.5 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 53.2% of the 92,264 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 23.8%, renter occupied; and 23.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 81,625 housing units in the area - 56.0% owner occupied, 20.3% renter occupied, and 23.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 5.60%. Median home value in the area is \$196,332, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 7.05% annually to \$276,052.
