In the identified area, the current year population is 34,659. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 28,340. The rate of change since 2010 was 2.82% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 39,347 representing a change of 2.57% annually from 2017 to 2022. Currently, the population is 48.3% male and 51.7% female.

Currently, 50.0% of the 25,847 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 13.1%, renter occupied; and 36.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 22,008 housing units in the area - 51.6% owner occupied, 10.6% renter occupied, and 37.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 7.41%. Median home value in the area is \$315,097, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.17% annually to \$386,442.
