The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 10.9 in the identified area, compared to 63.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 26.3% of the 9,996 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 10.1%, renter occupied; and 63.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 9,420 housing units in the area - 27.6% owner occupied, 8.9% renter occupied, and 63.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.67%. Median home value in the area is \$342,757, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.27% annually to \$383,392.
